02 Germany: Vessel arrest made (more) simple



- 1. Claims sec. 916 Code of Civil Procedure
 - 1.1. Vessel arrest possible for any monetary claim against vessel's owner
- 2. 2013 revision of law: simplified proceedings for vessel arrest sec. 917 Code of Civil Procedure
 - 2.1. before 2013: "good reason" required
 - 2.2. after 2013: for vessel arrests no "good reason" required

§ 917 Code of Civil Procedure

- (2) ... No grounds for a writ of seizure need to be given if the seizure is being implemented solely by way of securing the enforcement against a ship.



03 Germany: Vessel arrest and position on Counter-security

- 1. Overview: England & Wales position "ALKYON"
- 2. Position in Germany
 - 2.1. Judge may grant arrest but
 - allow the execution of the arrest only if creditor provides countersecurity
 - 2.2. Amount of counter-security
 - irrespective of the creditor's claim
 - potential damage
 - in the discretion of the judge
